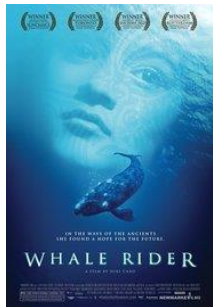

In a small New Zealand coastal village, Maori claim descent from Paikea, the Whale Rider. In every generation for over 1,000 years, a male heir born to the Chief succeeds to the title. The Chief's eldest son has twins - a boy and a girl. But the boy and his mother die in childbirth. The surviving girl is named Pai. This young Maori girl fights to fulfill a destiny her grandfather refuses to recognize. *A contemporary story of love, rejection and triumph.*

Young sprinter Chris Cahill (Mariel Hemingway) is having difficulty reaching her potential as an athlete, until she meets established track star Tory Skinner (Patrice Donnelly). At first the two women form a friendship as Tory and her coach (Scott Glenn) help Chris with her training. Gradually, they become intimate; but their relationship becomes complicated when Chris' improvement causes them to be competitors for the Olympic team. *Endowed with remarkable performances, superb photography, and a clear vision of what matters to its characters, Personal Best is an underappreciated gem in a genre full of filler.*

Three brilliant African-American women at NASA -- Katherine Johnson (Taraji P.
